



Product Care: Cleaning and Maintenance

FABRICS

Cleaning Code: WS (water or solvent based spot clean)

GENERAL CARE

The best way to keep Fil Doux fabric looking good is to properly maintain it.

This can be accomplished by performing regular maintenance (vacuuming with an upholstery attachment), brushing off dirt before it becomes embedded in the fabric, wiping up spills as soon as they occur, and spot cleaning soon after stains occur.

SPOT CLEANING

1. Blot to remove wet spills with a clean white cloth or tissue as soon as possible, rotating often to prevent transfer from the cloth. Avoid rubbing.
2. If the stain remains, blot with a with a clean white cloth or tissue moistened with water.
3. If water alone does not remove the stain, an upholstery shampoo/mild detergent can be used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions (*Apply a spot test in a discreet area to avoid discoloration*). Never apply the cleaning solution directly onto the upholstery but onto a dampened white cloth. This should then be rubbed gently onto the stain, working from the edge to the middle.
4. Rinse with lukewarm water to prevent the attraction of dirt.
5. Allow to dry before use.

Notes:

Always vacuum a set-in stain before treatment.

Several smaller applications of a cleaning agent are less harmful than one concentrated dose, repeat cleaning steps multiple times if necessary.

Pay attention to the type of stain, for example: oil-based stain should be addressed with a solvent, water-based stains respond better to soaps.

FABRICS WITH PRE-SHRINK TREATMENT

Cleaning Code: WASH (Machine Wash)

GENERAL CARE

The best way to keep Fil Doux fabric looking good is to properly maintain it.

This can be accomplished by simply brushing off dirt before it becomes embedded in the fabric, wiping up spills as soon as they occur, or spot cleaning soon after stains occur.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wash in cold water (under 60 degrees Fahrenheit) in front load washer (no agitator) on gentle.
2. Use a mild detergent. Do not bleach.
3. Damp dry the fabric on LOW heat for no more than three minutes.
4. Flat dry or replace SLIGHTLY damp on the furniture pieces.
